

Protection during optical cable line construction



Article Overview

Ensuring safety in optical cable construction requires strict adherence to PPE use, proper handling of fiber cables, eye protection, chemical safety, and compliance with regulatory standards.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

All personnel must wear standard construction safety gear, including hard hats, gloves, and safety boots, along with eye protection whenever working with fiber optics to prevent injury from shards or laser exposure . Supervisors should enforce PPE compliance and post warning signs in work areas where splicing or termination occurs .

Eye Safety

Fiber optic cables can emit invisible infrared light that may harm the cornea or lens. Never look directly into a fiber unless confirmed dark using a fiber optic power meter. Microscopes used for inspection should have infrared filters to reduce risk . Visual fault detectors and live fiber detectors help safely identify active fibers .

Cable Handling

- Bending Radius: Never bend cables below the minimum bending radius (typically $>20\times$ cable diameter) to avoid internal fiber breaks
