

Rapid Cooling of Optical Cable Fusion Splice Cold Shrink Tube



Article Overview

Rapid cooling of fusion splice heat-shrink tubes can be achieved using airflow, cooling pads, damp cloths, or low-temperature sprays to improve efficiency while ensuring proper sleeve setting.

Methods for Rapid Cooling

1. Airflow Cooling Using a small USB fan or the built-in cooling fan of the fusion splicer can accelerate heat dissipation from the heat-shrink tube. Compressed air can also be directed onto the splice, provided the fiber is dry and free from oil or debris to avoid contamination . 2. Cooling Pads or Metal Blocks Placing the spliced fiber on a metal cooling block or an aluminum heat-dissipating plate helps transfer heat away quickly. Some fusion splicers include dedicated cooling slots with high thermal conductivity to enhance this effect . 3. Damp Cloth or Wet Sponge Gently wiping the heat-shrink tube with a slightly damp, lint-free cloth or sponge accelerates cooling through evaporative heat absorption. Care must be taken to prevent moisture from entering the fiber joint . 4. Low-Temperature Cooling Sprays For industrial applications, electronic component cooling sprays (e.g., liquid CO₂) can rapidly cool the heat-shrink tube. This method is effective but should be used cautiously to avoid thermal shock or contamination . 5. Natural Cooling The standard method involves placing the fiber in the fusion splicer's cooling slot or on a dust-free pad for 1-2 minutes. While slower, this ensures the heat-shrink tube fully contracts and sets properly
