

Regulations on the Thickness of Sheet Metal for Indoor Electrical Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

The NEC does not specify exact sheet metal thickness for indoor electrical boxes; thickness is determined by material type, structural performance, and NEMA or UL standards.

NEC Requirements

The National Electrical Code (NEC) mandates that junction and distribution boxes be made of non-combustible, corrosion-resistant materials such as steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, and suitable for the installation environment (NEC 314.28) . NEC also requires proper grounding for metal boxes (NEC 250.110) and adequate volume for conductors (NEC 314.16) . However, the NEC does not prescribe a minimum gauge or thickness; it focuses on performance, safety, and material suitability .

Practical Sheet Metal Thickness Guidelines

For indoor electrical enclosures, engineering standards and NEMA/UL performance tests guide thickness selection:

- 14-gauge steel (~1.9 mm) is generally the minimum practical thickness for small industrial enclosures .
- 12-gauge steel (~2.7 mm) is recommended for larger doors or wall/floor units to p...
