- **Current Transformers (CTs):** Measure current in the transmission line and provide a scaled-down signal to the relay.
- **Protective Relay:** Monitors electrical quantities such as current, voltage, and frequency. When abnormal conditions like overcurrent or short circuits are detected, it sends a tripping signal.
- **Circuit Breaker (CB):** Receives the trip signal from the relay and isolates the faulty section of the system.
- **Tripping Circuit:** Connects the relay output to the CB coil, enabling the breaker to operate automatically during faults .

Components and Connections

- **Primary Circuit:** The transmission line or equipment being protected.
- **CT Secondary Circuit:** Connects the secondary winding of the CT to the relay input.
- **Relay Operating Coil:** Activates when the relay detects a fault.
- **Trip Circuit:** Completes the path to the CB coil, causing the breaker to open and is...
