Classification by Operating Mechanism

- Electromagnetic Relays: Operate using coils and moving parts to detect abnormal conditions. They are reliable and have been used historically in power systems.
- Static Relays: Use electronic components like thyristors or transistors to detect faults, offering faster response and higher accuracy
