

Requirements for the height of cable tray partitions



Article Overview

Cable tray partitions and vertical spacing must ensure at least 150 mm (6 inches) between trays, with a minimum 12-inch clearance above trays for maintenance, and covers in exposed areas should be at least 2.5 meters (8 feet) above grade.

Vertical Clearance and Partition Height

For safe and compliant cable tray installations, vertical spacing between floor-mounted trays should be at least 150 mm (6 inches) to allow for proper airflow, heat dissipation, and future cable additions, while preventing obstruction and maintaining structural integrity . Additionally, the 2026 NEC update requires a minimum of 12 inches of vertical clearance above cable trays to facilitate installation and maintenance access . In areas where cable trays are exposed to physical damage, such as vehicular traffic zones, covers should be installed at a minimum height of 2.5 meters (8 feet) above grade .

Horizontal and Parallel Tray Considerations

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0.6 meters to ensure adequate maintenance access, inspection, and airflow for heat dissipation . For power and signal cable separation, a minimum horizontal spacing of 0.5 meters is recommended, which can be reduced to 0.3 meters if shielding is used to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI),
