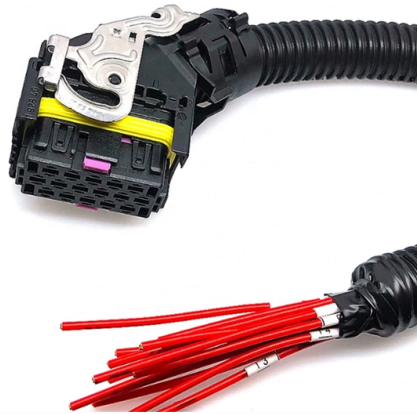


Requirements for the installation height of wiring in distribution boxes



Article Overview

Distribution boxes should generally be installed at a height of 1.4 to 1.8 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) above the floor for safe and convenient access.

Recommended Installation Heights

- Wall-mounted boxes (indoor): Mount at 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) to allow easy access without bending or stretching, ensuring safe operation and maintenance .
- Outdoor boxes: Place at least 0.9 meters (3 feet) above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts .
- Ground-mounted boxes: Raise 2 to 4 inches above the floor to prevent moisture damage .
- Residential considerations: For elderly or disabled users, a height of 1.3 meters is recommended for easier reach .
- Industrial settings: Distribution boards with IP54 protection typically require a mounting area with a maximum height of 1.2 meters for safe operation .

Wiring and Safety Considerations

- Ensure proper grounding of the metal box, electrical board, and appliances inside the box .
- Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load
