Ribbon Optical Cables

Ribbon optical cables consist of multiple optical fibers aligned side-by-side in a flat ribbon format, typically with 12 fibers per ribbon, though configurations can range from 4 to 24 fibers per ribbon . These ribbons are often stacked into a matrix and housed in a central tube or multiple loose tubes. The flat ribbon design allows for high fiber density, compact size, and efficient use of duct space, making them ideal for data centers, FTTH deployments, and backbone networks . Ribbon cables support mass fusion splicing, enabling multiple fibers to be spliced simultaneously, which significantly reduces installation time, labor costs, and downtime during repairs . Innovations like gel-free designs and pre-engineered bend performance further enhance installation speed and reliability .
