Core Layer Functionality

Core switches operate at the central backbone of a network, typically at Layer 3 of the OSI model, though many also support Layer 2 functions. Their primary role is to aggregate data from distribution switches and route it efficiently across the network, ensuring minimal latency and high throughput for large volumes of traffic . Unlike access switches, which connect directly to end-user devices, core switches focus on high-speed interconnectivity between network segments rather than inspecting or managing individual traffic flows .

- **Data Aggregation:** Core switches collect and consolidate traffic from distribution and access layers, enabling smooth communication across the network .
- **High Performance:** They are engineered for ultra-low latency and maximum throughput, supporting substantial traffic without creating bottlenecks .
- **Redundancy and Fault Tolerance:** Core switches often include redundant power supplies and links to maintain continuous operation even during component failures .
- **Scalability:** They allow networks to grow by accommodating higher bandwidth demands without compromising performance .
- **Security:** Core switches implement features like Access Control Lists (ACLs) and c...
