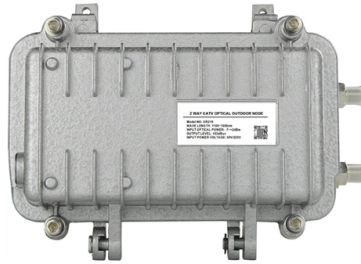


Safety of Highway Optical Cables to Ground



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables themselves carry no electrical current, but metallic components in highway installations must be properly grounded to ensure safety.

Electrical Safety and Grounding

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light, so the fiber core does not conduct electricity and does not require grounding on its own. However, many highway optical cables include metallic elements such as steel armoring, copper strength members, aluminum moisture barriers, or metallic messenger wires. These components must be grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and fire hazards. Fully dielectric cables with no metal content do not require grounding, but any metallic conduit or tray carrying fiber optic cables must also be grounded according to standard electrical codes, such as NEC Article 770 and NFPA 70. Grounding involves identifying metallic components, cleaning the bonding surface, attaching a UL-listed bonding clamp, and connecting a copper grounding conductor to the nearest grounding electrode or busbar .
