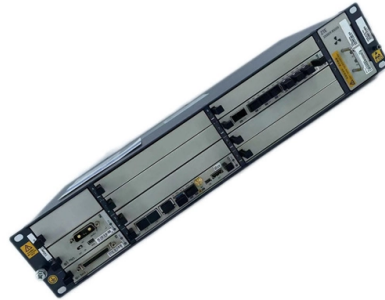


Separation Standards within Cable Trays



Article Overview

Proper cable tray separation ensures safety, reduces electromagnetic interference (EMI), and maintains compliance with NEC and TIA standards.

Purpose of Cable Tray Separation

Separation within cable trays is essential to prevent EMI, maintain signal integrity, and ensure safe operation of electrical systems. Power cables can induce noise into nearby low-voltage or communication cables, potentially causing data loss, signal degradation, or equipment malfunction. Segregation also facilitates inspection compliance, reduces rework, and improves heat dissipation in densely packed trays .

NEC and Industry Guidelines

The National Electrical Code (NEC) 2026, particularly Articles 725, 760, 770, 805, and 820, governs limited energy and communication cabling within trays. NEC 300.3(C) and related articles specify physical separation requirements for different voltage classes and mixed-voltage installations . Key points include:

- Class 1 vs Class 2/3 Circuits: NEC 725.136 prohibits Class 2/3 circuits from sharing space with Class 1 circuits unless reclassified and installed using Class 1 wiring methods .
- Power and Data Separation: Maintain physical spacing or use dividers to prevent interference, especially for high-power circuits and sensitive communication cables .
- PoE Considerations: High-power Power over Ethernet (PoE) cables should be treated as limited energy circuits, maintaining TIA-569-E spacing from AC power and followi...
