

Should the cables be run in cable trays

Yes, running cables in properly installed cable trays is recommended for organization, safety, and code compliance.

Benefits of Using Cable Trays

Cable trays provide a structured pathway for electrical conductors, keeping them organized, supported, and protected. They reduce the risk of overheating, electrical faults, and interference between power and data cables, while making maintenance and future upgrades easier. In industrial, commercial, and large-scale installations, cable trays are often more practical than running individual conduits, especially when routing dozens or hundreds of cables.

Compliance and Cable Types

According to NEC Article 392, only cables rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC), should be used in cable trays. Metallic trays can also serve as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) if properly bonded and continuous. Covers are optional but recommended in high-traffic areas or outdoor installations to protect cables from physical damage and environmental exposure.

Installation Guidelines

- Clearances: Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access
