

Spacing between buried optical cables and power lines



Article Overview

Direct-buried fiber optic cables should generally maintain a minimum separation of 12 inches (300 mm) from power cables, measured from the outer jackets of the cables, with adjustments for voltage and protective raceways.

Standard Requirements

According to NEC 770.47(B), direct-buried conductive fiber optic cables must be at least 12 inches (300 mm) away from power cables. This separation is typically measured from the outer surface of one cable to the outer surface of the other, rather than from center to center, to ensure adequate physical clearance and reduce the risk of damage during installation or maintenance (Mike Holt Forum discussion) . For high-voltage power cables, the 12-inch separation is generally considered sufficient for typical installations, but additional spacing may be required depending on local regulations, soil conditions, or induced voltage considerations. If the power cable is installed in a raceway, the separation requirement may be waived. The raceway can be metallic or non-metallic (PVC), but metallic raceways provide additional shielding and are preferred for high-voltage lines .

Practical Installation Considerations

- Depth of Burial: Fiber optic cables should be buried at a depth that protects them from surface activities and mechanical damage. Depth also affects thermal performance and ampacity if power cables are nearby
