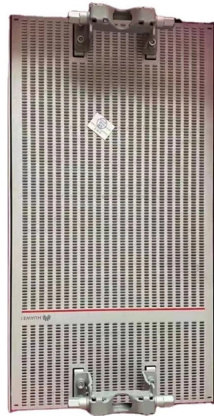


Standard Height of Aerial Optical Cable



Article Overview

Aerial optical cables must be installed at heights sufficient to clear obstacles, ensure safety, and comply with local and international standards, typically ranging from 5.5 to 7 meters above ground for public areas, with adjustments for cable type, span, and environmental conditions.

General Height Guidelines

Aerial optical cables should be installed high enough to avoid contact with pedestrians, vehicles, and other obstacles, while maintaining proper sag and tension along the span. Typical minimum clearances above ground in public areas are 5.5 to 7 meters, though this may vary depending on local regulations, road traffic, and environmental conditions. In remote or low-traffic areas, slightly lower heights may be acceptable, but safety and accessibility must always be considered.

Factors Affecting Installation Height

- Cable Type:
 - ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables can be installed near power lines in the power space, requiring careful clearance from electrical conductors.
 - Lashed cables require a messenger wire and are typically installed in the telecom space, with sag and tension carefully calculated.
- Span Length and Sag:
 - Sag is generally limited to less than 2% of the span length, and maximum tension should not exceed 30% of the cable's minimum breaking strength.
 - Longer spans or heavier cables may require higher installation points to maintain...
