

Standard Requirements for Splicing Armored Optical Cables



Article Overview

Armored optical cable splicing requires careful fiber preparation, precise alignment, armor continuity verification, and protective encapsulation to ensure mechanical and optical integrity.

Cable Preparation

Before splicing, the armored cable must be properly prepared. This includes cutting the cable to the desired length, stripping the outer armor and jacket without damaging the fiber, and cleaning the fiber with alcohol and lint-free wipes. For polyimide-coated fibers, a buffer tube may be inserted to protect the fiber during handling (). Kevlar strength members should be cut close to the jacket, and care must be taken to avoid heat damage when cutting metallic armor ().

Fiber Splicing

Fusion splicing is the preferred method for armored optical cables, providing low-loss, permanent connections. Fibers must be precisely aligned using core or cladding alignment techniques, and the splice should be protected with heat-shrink tubing or mechanical splice enclosures (). Typical splice loss for single-mode fibers is 0.1 dB or lower, with modern splicers capable of achieving losses below 0.02 dB ().
