

Terminal directly connected to core switch



Article Overview

Connecting a terminal or host directly to a core switch is possible but generally discouraged due to potential risks to network stability and security.

Risks and Considerations

Directly connecting a host PC or terminal to a core switch can introduce instability, as any misconfigured or compromised device may impact the core switch, which is critical for the entire network's operation. Typically, end devices are connected to access switches, which then uplink to the core switch. However, if no access switch ports are available, a direct connection can be made cautiously, preferably for production servers or trusted devices rather than general user PCs (Cisco Community) .

Console Access

For management and configuration, the console port on the core switch is the recommended method. This provides out-of-band access, allowing administrators to configure the switch even if the network is down. Console ports are usually RJ45 serial or USB-based, and connecting a terminal requires a console cable (RJ45-to-serial or USB-to-serial adapter) and terminal emulation software like PuTTY, SecureCRT, or Tera Term (Router-Switch, FS.com) . Standard console settings are typically 9600 baud, 8 data bits, 1 stop bit, no parity, no flow control, though some newer switches may require 115200 baud....
