Modular designs allow flexible port configurations and scalability . **Power Supply:** Core switches include dual or redundant power supplies to maintain uninterrupted operation. Reliable power is critical for mission-critical environments where downtime is unacceptable . **Cooling System:** High-performance core switches generate significant heat, so integrated cooling systems maintain optimal operating temperatures to ensure stability and longevity . **Additional Features:** Many core switches also support hot-swappable modules, link aggregation (LAG), high availability protocols like HSRP/VRRP, ACLs, 802.1X authentication, and network management interfaces such as SNMP or CLI/Web GUI .
