In installations where an optical fiber cable is exposed to contact with electric light or power conductors and the cable enters the building, the non-current-carrying metallic members shall be either grounded as specified in 770. 100, or interrupted by an insulating joint or. Sheath Retention - The cable sheath should be secured so that it will not pull out of a closure when subjected to a pull out force of 445 N (100 lbf). The sheath retention requirement is to ensure the closure clamping hardware can isolate fibers and fiber optic splices from tensile stresses applied.
