Three-level distribution boxes are classified into main, sub, and terminal levels, each serving distinct roles in power distribution, protection, and load management.

Overview of Three-Level Distribution

A three-level distribution system organizes electrical power from the main supply to end-use equipment in a hierarchical manner. This structure ensures efficient load management, safety, and fault isolation. The levels are:

- **First-Level (Main Distribution Box)**
 - Acts as the primary hub for incoming power.
 - Typically installed near the power source or transformer.
 - Handles large output capacity and high electrical parameters.
 - Provides protection, monitoring, and control for downstream distribution boxes.
 - Often includes main circuit breakers and residual current devices (RCDs) for two-stage protection .
- **Second-Level (Sub-Distribution Box)**
 - Receives power from the main distribution box and redistributes it to localized areas or specific equipment clusters.
 - Used in areas with scattered loads or multiple circuits.
 - Contains branch circuit protection switches to safeguard individual circuits.
 - Load capacity typically ranges from 50-150 kW, depending on the number of connected terminal boxes and equipment
