Pipelines should maintain proper clearance from cable trays, with anti-corrosion and insulation measures applied if minimum distances cannot be met.

Clearance and Safety Distances

When pipelines are not connected to cable trays, it is essential to maintain adequate separation to prevent electrical hazards, heat damage, or corrosion. For thermal pipelines with insulation, the parallel safety distance from cable trays should be at least 0.5 meters, and 1 meter if insulation is absent. For common process pipes, a minimum distance of 0.4 meters is recommended. Pipelines carrying corrosive liquids or gases require at least 0.5 meters clearance, with protective coatings or corrosion-resistant covers applied if trays are nearby .

Installation Orientation

Cable trays should generally be installed on one side of the pipe rack and not directly above corrosive or thermal pipelines. If crossing is unavoidable, protective measures such as thermal insulation boards or corrosion-resistant cover plates should be used, with the length of protection extending at least $d + 2000$ mm, where d is the pipeline diameter .
