What a Protective Relay Does

A protective relay is an automatic device that monitors electrical circuits for abnormal conditions such as overcurrent, overvoltage, undervoltage, or short circuits. When it detects a fault, it triggers a circuit breaker to disconnect the affected section, preventing damage to appliances and reducing the risk of fire (). In a household, this ensures that sensitive electronics like TVs, computers, and refrigerators are protected from sudden voltage fluctuations ().

Types of Household Relays

- Overvoltage Relay: Activates when the voltage exceeds a safe threshold, cutting off power to prevent damage from surges ().
- Undervoltage Relay: Activates when voltage drops below a safe level, protecting motors and electronics from stress ().
- Combined Overvoltage/Undervoltage Relay: Many modern devices integrate both protections in a single unit for comprehensive voltage safety ().
