Core switches are positioned at the backbone of large-scale networks, providing ultra-low latency, high throughput, and high reliability for massive volumes of traffic . They typically feature:

- Layer 3 routing capabilities for VLANs, subnets, and inter-network traffic.
 - High port density and bandwidth, supporting 10G, 40G, 100G, or even 400G connections .
 - Redundancy and high availability, including dual power supplies, hot-swappable modules, and protocols like HSRP or VRRP to prevent downtime .
 - Scalability, often using modular chassis designs to expand as network demands grow .
 - Advanced management features, such as ACLs, SNMP, and network access control.
- Core switches are essential for networks with hundreds of devices or high-bandwidth applications like VoIP, video conferencing, or data centers, ensuring stability and efficient traffic routing .
