

What are the optical port modes of a switch



Article Overview

Optical switch port mode determines whether a port operates as an optical interface, an electrical interface, or in a specific routing configuration for fiber networks.

Optical vs Electrical Port Modes

On modern network switches, combo interfaces often include both a copper (electrical) and an optical port. Only one interface can operate at a time: enabling the optical port disables the electrical port and vice versa. The port mode can be set manually or automatically, and attributes such as speed and duplex are configured in the same interface view regardless of the selected medium . This allows flexible deployment depending on network requirements.

Fiber Optic Switch Port Modes

Fiber optic switches, used in test or communication systems, have ports that can operate in different modes:

- Single-mode vs Multimode: Ports are designed for either single-mode or multimode fibers, affecting distance and wavelength compatibility .
- Blocking vs Non-blocking: In blocking mode, some input fibers may be restricted from connecting to certain outputs if other connections are active. Non-blocking mode allows any input to connect to any output without limitation .
- Bi-directional and Transparent: Many optical switches are fully bi-directional and t...
