Its design features continuous perforations, which allow for maximum airflow around cables, helping to prevent overheating and enabling easy attachment of cable ties . The tray is suitable for low-profile installations or areas requiring a shallow cable-laying depth while maintaining strong load-bearing capabilities .

- Perforated Structure: Enhances ventilation and cable security.
- Taper Folded Edges: Allow smooth joining of tray lengths and fittings, creating a flexible and reliable cable network .
- Cabin Widths: Available in sizes ranging from 75 mm to 600 mm, accommodating various cable volumes .
- Return Sides: Standard 20 mm return sides on straight lengths provide additional strength .
