

What does residual voltage mean in relay protection



Article Overview

Residual voltage in relay protection refers to the voltage measured from the vector sum of all three-phase voltages, used to detect unbalanced or earth-fault conditions in power systems.

Definition and Concept

Residual voltage is the voltage that remains when the three-phase voltages are summed vectorially, often denoted as U_0 . In a perfectly balanced three-phase system, the sum of the three phase voltages is zero. However, during faults such as earth faults, phase-to-ground faults, or unbalanced loads, a non-zero residual voltage appears. Protective relays monitor this residual voltage to detect abnormal conditions and initiate tripping if necessary.

Application in Relays

Residual voltage relays are typically part of a voltage protection scheme that includes overvoltage, undervoltage, and residual overvoltage modules. These relays often have two stages:

- Low-set stage ($U_0 >$): Detects minor residual voltage deviations and can trigger alarms or initiate controlled responses.
- High-set stage ($U_0 >>$): Detects severe residual voltage conditions and can directly trip circuit breakers to isolate the fault. Both stages usually have definite time char...
