

What is conventional relay protection

Conventional relay protection uses electromechanical or basic static relays to detect electrical faults and isolate faulty sections, ensuring system safety and reliability.

Overview

Conventional relay protection is a fundamental method in power system protection, relying primarily on electromechanical relays that operate using coils, moving parts, and magnetic forces to detect abnormal conditions such as overcurrent, overvoltage, underfrequency, or reverse power flow (). These relays act automatically to trip circuit breakers and isolate the faulty section, preventing damage to equipment and maintaining system stability ().

Operating Principles

Conventional relays operate by sensing an actuating quantity (current or voltage) that exceeds a predefined threshold. When this quantity reaches the pickup level, the relay mechanism activates, closing its contacts to complete the trip circuit of a breaker. Once the fault is cleared and the quantity falls below the reset level, the relay returns to its original state (). This ensures fast and selective fault isolation.
