

What is the distance between cable trays



Article Overview

The recommended distance between parallel cable trays is generally at least 0.6 meters, with specific clearances for power and signal trays and vertical spacing for maintenance and airflow.

Horizontal Spacing

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the minimum horizontal distance should be 0.6 meters to allow maintenance access, inspection, and proper heat dissipation, while preventing cables from touching and causing interference or short circuits (Apex Tray) . For power and signal (control) trays, a horizontal separation of at least 0.5 meters is recommended to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI). If the trays are shielded, this distance can be reduced to 0.3 meters (Apex Tray) . Industry standards also suggest a minimum of 300 mm (12 inches) between power and instrumentation trays to reduce EMI (Zero Instrument) .

Vertical Spacing

For floor-mounted or stacked trays, the minimum vertical clearance is 150 mm to prevent obstruction, allow ventilation, and facilitate future installation of additional trays (Apex Tray) . When trays are near ventilation ducts, a vertical clearance of at least 300 mm is recommended to ensure proper airflow and prevent overheating (Apex Tray) .
