

What is the fiber optic box for home access called



Overview

A Fiber Access Terminal (FAT) is a key passive device used in FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) and other optical communication networks. It provides a secure and organized point for fiber cabling, splicing, splitting, and distribution, while ensuring reliable protection and easy management for long-term. The ONT is a box that sits directly at the entry point to your home and receives light signals from fiber optic cables. You can think of an ONT as your interpreter: It translates fiber light signals to electrical signals that can be transmitted to your fiber router. " This term defines the physical boundary where the service provider's network infrastructure ends and the customer's internal wiring begins.
