

What is the ideal height for a power distribution box

The recommended installation height for a power distribution box is generally between 1.4 meters and 1.8 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) from the floor, ensuring accessibility, safety, and compliance with standards.

Residential Installation

For residential settings, distribution boxes should be mounted at a height that allows easy access without bending or stretching excessively. The typical range is 1.4 to 1.7 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users to facilitate operation and maintenance. This height also protects the box from accidental water exposure, impacts, and ensures readability of labels and meters. Wall-mounted boxes should be placed in dry, well-ventilated areas, away from sinks or damp locations.

Outdoor and Floor-Mounted Boxes

For outdoor installations, the bottom of the box should be at least 0.9 meters (3 feet) above ground to prevent water ingress and dirt accumulation. Floor-mounted boxes should have the back panel raised 0.5 meters above the ground, with additional clearance in damp environments. These measures reduce the risk of electric shock and equipment damage.
