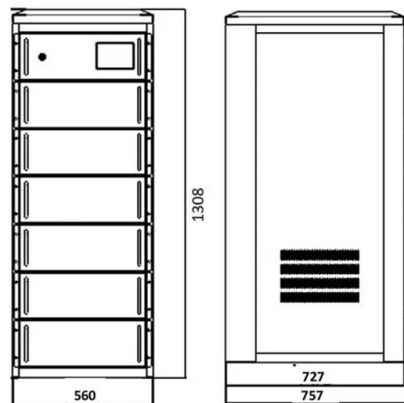


What is the standard core number of a national standard optical cable



Article Overview

The standard core number for a national standard optical cable is typically 12 cores for a communication room and 24 cores for a building room, with additional cores for redundancy.

Core Number Guidelines

National standards for optical cables recommend 12-core cables for communication rooms and 24-core cables for building rooms as a general guideline, ensuring sufficient capacity for typical network connections and future expansion. The total number of cores is usually calculated as:

- Total equipment interfaces $\times 2$, plus
- 10% to 20% spare cores for redundancy and maintenance. This ensures that the network can accommodate active connections while providing spare fibers for repairs or future upgrades.

Considerations for Core Selection

- Redundancy and Hot Standby: If a core switch is configured for dual-machine hot standby, 6 cores may suffice, with 2 cores per switch and 2 spare cores.
- Serial Communication and Multiplexing: When equipment supports serial communication or multiplexing, the required number of cores can be reduced.
- Single-mode vs Multi-mode: Single-mode fibers are preferred for long-distance outdoor transmission, while multi-mode fibers are suitable for shorter distances and...
