

What is the torque requirement for the bus connector



Article Overview

The typical torque requirement for copper busbar connections ranges from 20 N·m to 70 N·m depending on bolt size, spacing, and manufacturer specifications.

General Guidelines

Proper torque is critical for busbar connections to ensure stable, low-resistance contact and long-term reliability under thermal cycling. Insufficient torque can lead to high contact resistance, overheating, and potential failure, while over-tightening can damage the busbar or fasteners. Torque values are determined by the force needed to achieve stable clamping, not by overlap width or theoretical minimums.

Manufacturer and Standard Values

- For copper busbars wider than 40 mm using M12 bolts spaced 30–50 mm apart, torque values are recommended above 70 N·m.
- For Powerpact L frame breakers, the busbar connection torque is 50 N·m (442 lb-in).
- For Masterpact NT & NW bars, copper busbars with steel nuts and bolts (class 8.8) follow manufacturer-specified torque tables, which generally align with the 50–70 N·m range for reliable clamping.
- Lower general reference values (31–39 N·m) may meet static calculations but often fail long-term reliability expectations
