EU Tariff Quotas and Suspensions

Pigtails and couplers, as components incorporated into aircraft, are often covered under autonomous tariff suspensions and quotas. These measures allow the total or partial suspension of normal import duties for strategic components not sufficiently produced in the EU, including parts for aircraft manufacture, repair, or maintenance. The relevant legal framework is Council Regulation (EU) 2018/581, implemented through Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1517, which lists the specific commodity codes eligible for duty suspension and the required certificates, such as an Authorised Release Certificate (EASA Form One).

How Quotas Work

- **Quantity Limits:** Quotas set a maximum quantity of goods that can be imported at reduced or zero duty within a defined period, often a calendar year.
- **First-Come, First-Served:** Many EU quotas are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, meaning importers must submit declarations promptly to benefit from the quota.
- **Post-Quota Duty:** Once the quota is exhausted, imports are subject to the standard...
