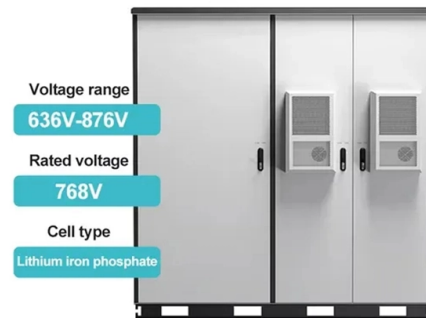


Where is a typical fiber optic splitter located in Belgium



Article Overview

Fiber optic splitters in Belgium are typically located in building entrance facilities, central offices, or outdoor distribution boxes, with cascaded splitters sometimes installed on individual floors or near user clusters.

Indoor Placement

In residential or commercial buildings, splitters are often installed in the building's entrance facility or main telecom room. From this point, drop cables run to each unit, minimizing the number of fibers entering the building while allowing efficient distribution to multiple subscribers. In high-rise or multi-dwelling units (MDUs), splitters can also be cascaded, with a primary splitter in the entrance facility feeding secondary splitters on each floor or in corridor wiring boxes. This approach supports large numbers of users while optimizing fiber usage and signal strength.

Other indoor locations include:

- Community central computer rooms or telecom closets for first-level splitting.
- Floor wiring boxes or weak current wells for secondary splitting, especially in high-density buildings.
- Corridors or dedicated equipment racks where space and accessibility allow.
