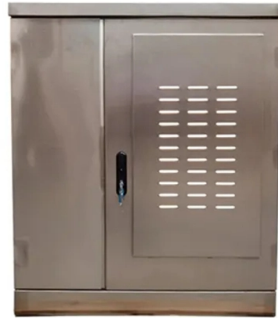


Where to return a telecommunications fiber optic terminal box



Article Overview

Telecommunications fiber optic terminal boxes, such as ONTs, should be returned to your service provider or via the designated returns process, often free of charge.

Returning Equipment to Your Provider

If the fiber optic terminal box belongs to your broadband provider (for example, Openreach in the UK), it is considered part of the network infrastructure and must not be removed without authorization. Unauthorized removal can cause service interruptions or incur charges. When moving out or switching providers, you should follow the official return process provided by your service provider .

Steps for Returning Equipment

- **Check Instructions from Your Provider:** Confirm which equipment needs to be returned. This may include the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), power supply units, and associated cabling .
- **Use the Official Returns Portal:** Many providers, such as Openreach, offer a Royal Mail returns portal. You can generate a QR code for your return, which will be scanned at the Post Office to create a shipping label on the spot .
- **Pack Equipment Securely:** Place the terminal box and any other required items in a sturdy box or padded envelope to prevent damage during transit .
- **Drop Off at Post Office:** Take the packed equipment and QR code to your nearest Post Office. The return is typically free of charge, and the equipment will be responsibly recycled through approved partners
