In cable tray installations, high-voltage cables are usually positioned higher than low-voltage cables. Low-voltage cables, such as control, instrumentation, or communication lines, are more sensitive to electromagnetic interference from high-voltage conductors, so keeping them below or separated helps maintain signal integrity .

### Regulatory and Safety Considerations

- **Voltage Ratings:** All cables in a tray must have insulation rated for the highest voltage present in that tray. For example, if a tray contains a 480V circuit, all cables must be insulated for at least 480V .
- **Physical Separation:** For circuits above 600V, low-voltage and high-voltage cables cannot share the same tray without a physical barrier. Metal dividers or separate trays are required to prevent accidental contact and ensure compliance with safety codes .
- **Standards:** The National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 300.3(C) and Article 392 provide guidance on cable segregation and installation practices. In Europe, IEC sta...
