

Which type of fiber optic cable is best for indoor wiring

For indoor wiring, tight-buffered fiber optic cables with appropriate fire-rated jackets (plenum or riser) are typically recommended, using single-mode for long distances and multimode for shorter runs.

Fiber Type

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Features a small core (typically $9/125\mu\text{m}$) and is ideal for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, such as connecting multiple floors or buildings within a campus network .
- Multimode fiber (MMF): Has a larger core ($50/125\mu\text{m}$ or $62.5/125\mu\text{m}$) and is suitable for shorter distances, like within a single building or data center, offering cost-effective installation and easier handling .

Cable Construction

- Tight-buffered cables: Each fiber is coated with a protective 900-micron buffer, making it flexible, easy to handle, and suitable for indoor environments . They come in:
 - Simplex: Single fiber, often used for patch cords.
 - Duplex/Zipcord: Two fibers joined together, common for direct connections.
 - Distribution: Multiple fibers under one jacket, ideal for conduit runs.
 - Breakout: Several individually jacketed fibers bundled together, suitable for direct termination without patch panels
