

Wiring of Zero-Level Terminals in Inter-Frequency Shift Cabinet



Article Overview

Zero-level terminals should be wired with careful attention to grounding, separation from power circuits, and EMC compliance to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Grounding and Zero-Level Connections

Zero-level terminals, often representing the reference or 0V point in control circuits, must be connected to a proper ground or common reference point within the cabinet. This ensures that all control signals have a consistent reference and prevents ground potential differences that can disrupt communication or cause signal errors . Key practices include:

- **Star Grounding:** Connect all zero-level terminals to a single central grounding point to minimize voltage differences between circuits .
- **Cabinet Frame Bonding:** Ground the zero-level terminals to the cabinet frame using low-impedance connections, ensuring short and direct paths .
- **Shielded Cable Termination:** If control cables are shielded, connect the shield to the zero-level or ground at the cabinet entry point, preferably near the terminals, to reduce electromagnetic interference .
